## Our purpose

- To provide a child friendly facility with a caring and trained staff under the direct supervision of the PRCA/FRC Board to meet the needs of children who have disclosed abuse and their families.
- To provide a multi-disciplinary team response to child abuse allegations which meet regularly. This will allow for the interaction of professions and input to minimize duplication of services but will ensure prompt and ongoing services.
- 3. To provide case review after forensic interviews and case tracking of child abuse cases using NCA trak which will coordinate all agency information.
  - 4. To provide a videotaped interview by a highly trained child interviewer. This feature of the program will reduce additional trauma by preventing many interviews.
- To provide therapy and services for children and non-offending caregivers either in house or by referral with other appropriate treatment providers as well as specialized medical referral and exams.
- 6. To provide training for multidisciplinary team members, forensic interviewers, and medical personnel on an annual basis.
  - 7. To achieve safe, sustainable, and healthy families and communities.
